FA - "Factory / Master cards" Four types of Factory-Cards exist and samples shown under FA1 and FA2 are courtesy from Landis & Gyr. Cards never exit the factory of Zug (Switzerland) and were destroyed when the factory closed in March 2006. The optical geometry of each Factory-Card is perfect and the production costs of such material was high. Factory-Cards of a structure were used to control the quality of Public-Cards with same structure. -----

FA1 - "Settings-Cards / Eich-Karten" For each system of countries, 26 sets of cards were produced (from "set #A" to "set #Z") with 5 cards in each set (for example card #A-1 to #A-5 for the "#A set" - cards were mostly numbered per hand). Such cards always bear the number of the structure (Stu. 1 to 26) in the middle front of the card.

Country code is visible on the left of the optical track.

Settings-Card for countries with Structure 11 (Stu. 11) -----

FA2 - "Monitorings-Cards / Überwachungs-Karten"

For each system of countries, 26 sets of cards were produced (from "set #A" to "set #Z") with 5 cards in each set (for example card #A-1 to #A-5 for the "#A set" - cards were mostly numbered per hand).

Such cards always bear the number of the structure (Stu. 1 to 26) in the middle front of the card.

Front-color of the card is the official color awarded by Landis & Gyr for the card's country/system :

GREEN for England (Stu. 07), **YELLOW** for Austria (Stu. 08), **RED** for Switzerland (Stu. 03), etc...
